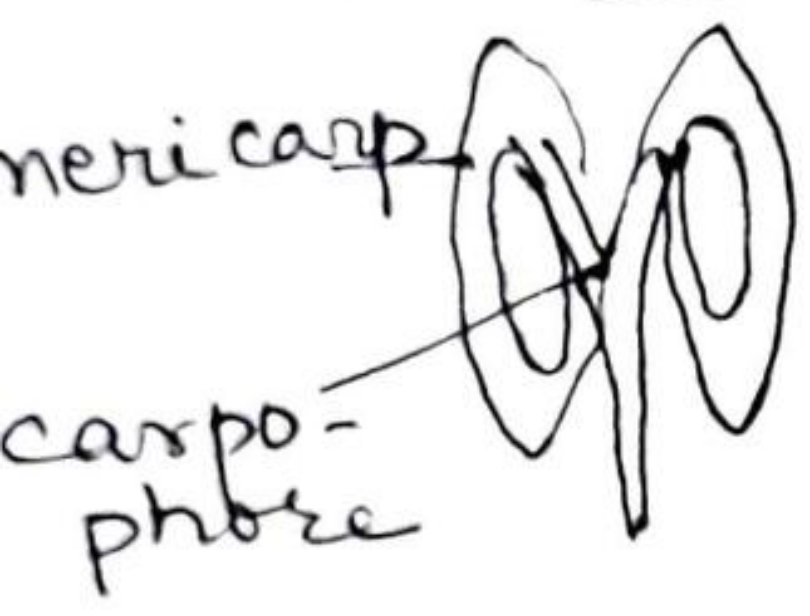
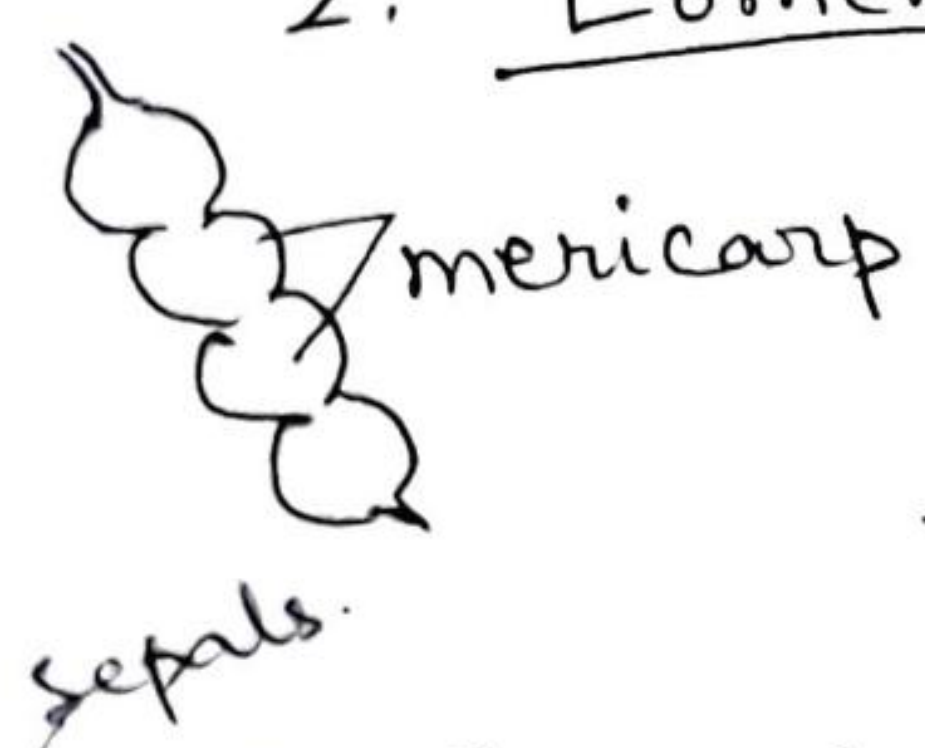


Schizocarpic Fruits :- Divides into many one seeded segments which is called mericarp.

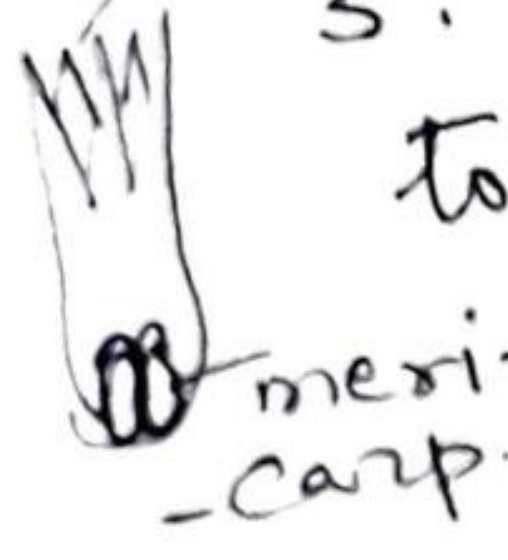
1. Creomocarp :- Carpel-2, inferior ovary with 2 seeds. After maturation splits into 2 segments / mericarps attached to the carpophore which is extended thalamus. eg. Coriandrum sativum.



2. Lomentum :- Carpel-one, superior ovary, modified legume which divides into many one seeded mericarps by transverse constriction. eg. Tamarindus indica.



3. Carcerule :- Carpel-2. Four chamber due to false partition. Each chamber contains one seed. eg. Ocimum sanctum (tulsi).



4. Regma Carpel 3-5, Divides into parts as many as carpels. eg. Ricinus communis (castor).



5. Samara :- Carpels-2-more, pericarp flattens to form wings.
