### Action Taken Report

The Coordinator informed that

- Solar panels have been installed in the Administrative Building and are fully operational.
- The following steps have been taken to increase the retention of students admitted to the various courses offered by the college:
  - Personalised welcome mail from Principal to each student informing her of all the services offered by the college apart from curriculum delivery.
  - Special classes on subject specific computer programmes, processing of statistical data and career counselling programs.
- A community service centre called 'Sister Nivedita Community Service Centre-JDC' has been started by the college with both teacher and student members to reach out to the elderly and people affected by the pandemic.
- The recommendations of the internal AAA team are being closely followed
- Arrangements have been made for a 30-hour course on upcycling of discarded material which is to be conducted by the college where both trainer and trainees will be college students. The college will also provide the necessary space for a 'Trash to Treasure Boutique' where the upcycled products may be displayed and sold.
- Arrangements have been made for the following courses on foreign languages:
  - German Course to restart in online mode
  - o New French Course to start from this session

#### **Resolutions taken in present meeting**

- External Academic and Administrative Audit to be conducted in the last week of September, 2021 for the sessions 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-2020.
- Green Audit to be conducted within this month and Energy Audit to be conducted as soon as possible for the sessions 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-2020.
