Agenda: ii) Preparation for accreditation by NAAC Resolutions taken in present meeting:

- Principal introduced Ms. Ankita Chatterjee, Sem IV, Geology Department as student member and Mr. Upal Misra, father of Ushashi Misra, Sem II, Economics Department, as guardian member of IQAC.
- Principal briefed the new members of IQAC about the NAAC activities and developments of the college.
 - 93 key indicators play the role of evaluation by NAAC. 70% marking will be done online for which documents to be uploaded in the respective portal. 15% will be evaluated on

- the basis of feedbacks taken from the present students. Rest 15% will be evaluated by physical inspection during which the IQAC team will be involved especially the external members. That is why they need to be briefed regularly about the college activities.
- Principal also quoted that AQAR 20-21 has been submitted and it has been realized that
 the college lacks in sectors viz. Add-On Course and Waste Management. Accordingly
 measures are being taken in the subsequent year.
 - It is decided that compulsory subject specific Add On courses will be introduced for Sem-4 students.Add-On Course Co-ordinators from each departments have been finalised and the courses are being started shortly.
 - E-waste management report as Bulk Consumer has to be submitted annually to West Bengal Pollution Control Board. Green Audit and Energy Audit have been already conducted. Zoology Lab waste and canteen waste management need to be addressed properly.
- External Academic Audits have been conducted for the academic years 17-18, 18-19, 19-20.
- Since NAAC sub-committees have to be updated according to NAAC stipulations, new sub-committees have been formed.
- Annual Stakeholders' Meet will be held shortly with the members of Governing Body,
 IQAC, NAAC steering committee, students, guardians, employers and alumni.
- In order to make college Self-Reliant as much as possible, college tries to utilize its
 resources and programs like "Trash to Treasure", "Spring Board" etc.have been
 conducted under this theme. To cultivate this idea more, a workshop on Self Reliance is
 resolved to be held. As part of this, it is proposed that entrepreneurs among ex-students
 of our college may be invited to enlighten our present students.
- Prof. P. K. Chaudhuri, external member commented on the Best Practice and Institutional Distinctiveness. He opined that our college is one of the pioneering girls' college to offer Geology Honours and having the CU toppers in the respective subject. He also opined that college may find out collaboration activity with Bhawanipore Education Society College which has a good Fashion Designing course. Principal pointed out the constraints regarding the financial viability of the course.
- Principal also pointed out the difficulty in finding out the collaborative institutions.
 Maximum institutions are not responding except E-Pathsala conducted by Bengali
 Departments of our college, Lady Brabourne college and Piary Mohon College.

• Prof. Papiya Ghosh, external member pointed out that IPR and Research Methodology carry 3 marks for each year. So workshops for these may be conducted every year. In criterion 6, Faculty upgradation and Training Programs, faculty may be sponsored financially for international seminar presentations. Students' data base have to be prepared carefully for SSR and they have to be briefed properly. All possible documents have to be uploaded, more the volume the better. Regarding research publications, the links of the publications are to be given. If link is not possible, then front page of the publication should be uploaded. All additional information should be provided even if they are repeated. Data for placement of alumni must be provided.
