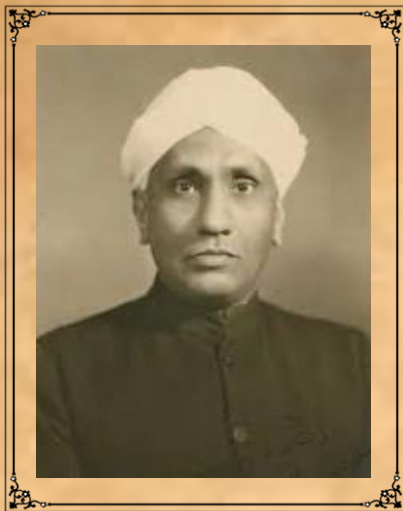

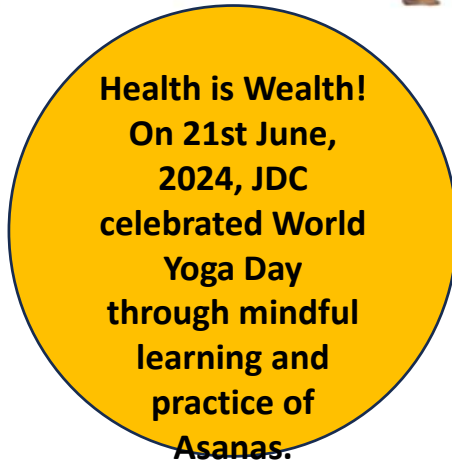
National Science Day 2024

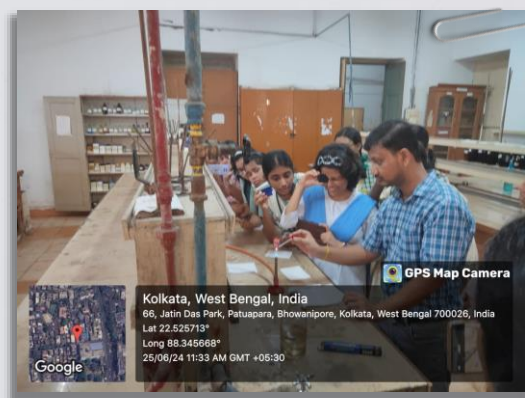

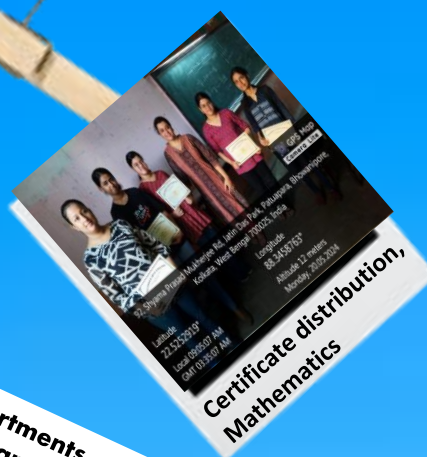

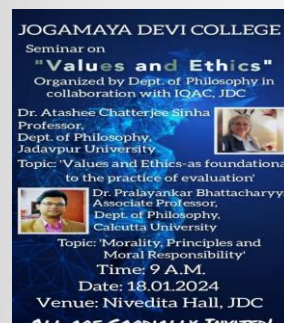
JDC Collaborates!
