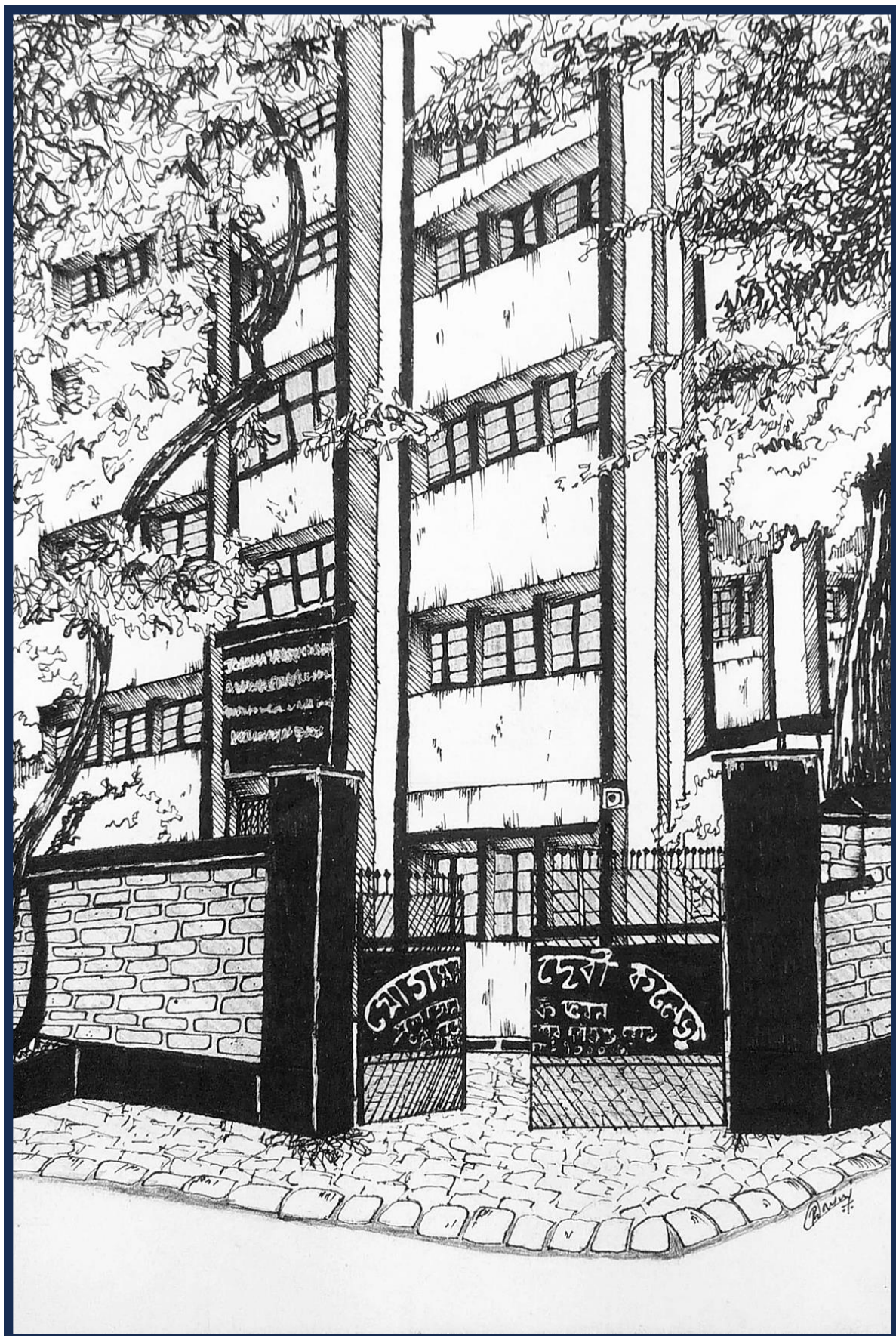

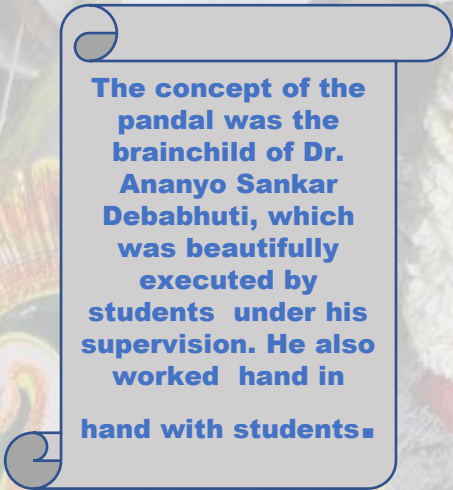
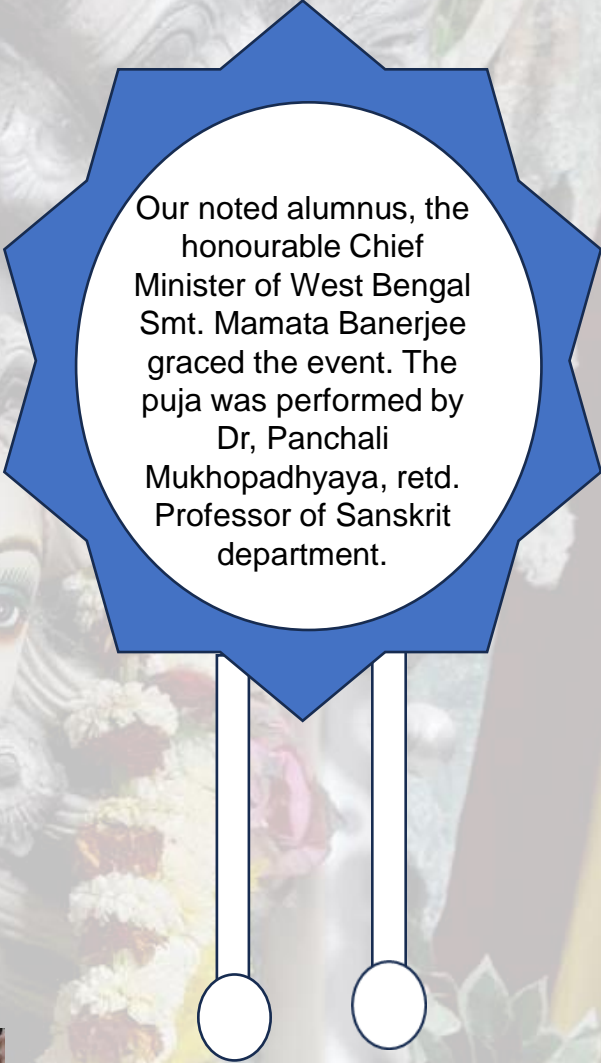


Cultural Programme/NAAC Visit

JDC Annual Sports 2022-2023



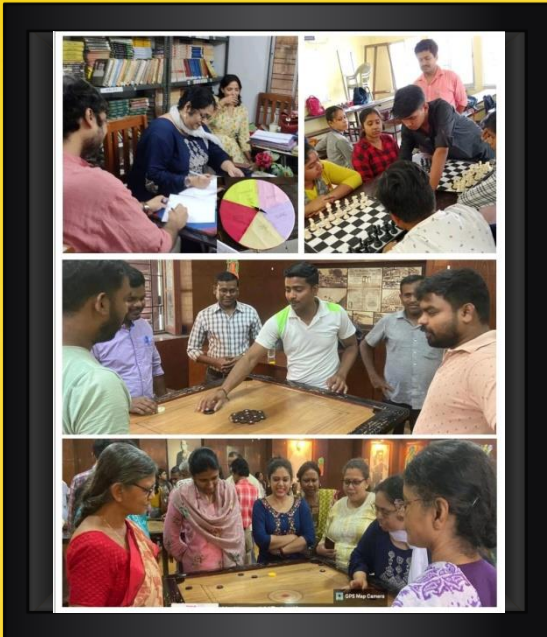

Yoga is a great way to holistically heal our mind and body. Our college has celebrated this ancient knowledge this year in many ways; a yoga performance was held on Sports' Day!



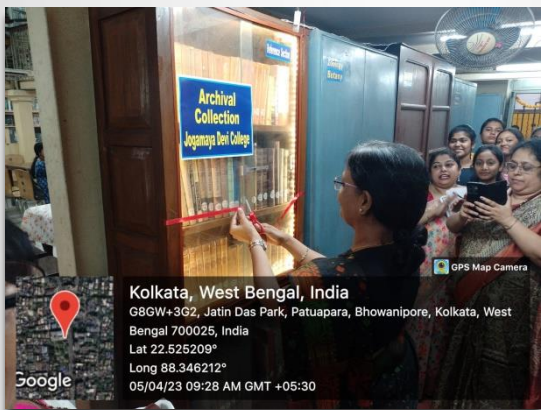

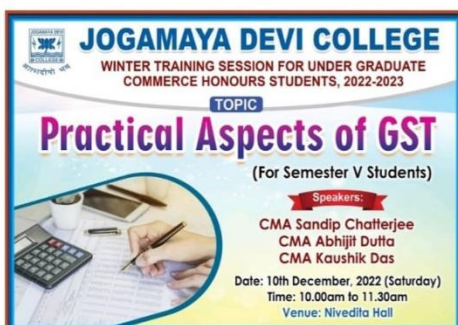

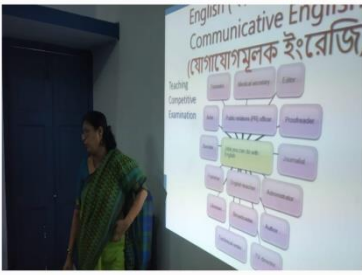
